How to become a SAFA full member?

You can apply for full SAFA membership if...

- You have completed a five-year university-level Master's degree in architecture in Finland.
- Or you have completed a five-year university-level architect's degree abroad.
 - A five-year academic degree fulfilling the requirements of the EU directive recognizing professional qualifications of architects, or an equivalent degree as an architect.

- Regarding degrees done in EU member states, all the additional studies required by the automatic qualification have to be completed as well.
- The equivalency of the degree is evaluated by the Finnish National Agency for Education (EDUFI).
 - Those who have graduated as architects abroad are required to attach a certificate of equivalency by EDUFI to their membership application form.

- Publications *Finnish Architectural Review* and *Arkkitehtiuutiset* delivered to your home.




- Inexpensive participation fees to SAFA events and trainings.

 - This year Arkkitehtipäivät is held in Seinäjoki in May.





How much SAFA membership costs?

- Full members membership fee is 499 € / year.
- Student membership is free for undergraduate students → After three years of studying, the membership fee is 25 € / year.

If you have just graduated, the payment increases in steps annually:

- After graduation 12 months 124,75 € (discount 75 %)
- After graduation 13-24 months 249,50 € (discount 50 %)
- After graduation 25-36 months 374,25 € (discount 25 %)

Employed architects can become **SAFA-TEK joint members** and enjoy the benefits from both organizations without any extra cost.

SAFA local sections

- As a member of SAFA, you automatically belong to one of our 13 local sections which function as collegial collectives in their own regions.
